Student Graduation Rates for 2019-2020

The federal Student-Right-To-Know act requires institutions to make completion rates available upon request to prospective students and other interested parties. The act defines the cohort of students on which the institution must report. The cohort is comprised of “first time, full time degree or certificate seeking” students that completed their program of study within 150% of their “normal” program length.

American College of Health Care and Technology annually reports completion rates through the IPEDS (*Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System*) web site. The overall graduation rate is also known as the Student-Right-to-Know or IPEDS graduation rate. Graduation rates can be measured over different length of time; “normal time” is the typical amount of time it takes full time students to complete their program of study.
